CLP notifications for boron

In our email of April 16th 2012, we made reference to several classifications for boron arising from CLP notifications:

acute toxicity - oral [cat. 4]
skin corrosion/irritation [cat. 2]
serious eye damage / eye irritation [cat. 2]
flammable solids [cat. 1]
pyrophoric solids [cat. 1]
hazardous to the aquatic environment [cat. 4]

We requested that those who made these classifications get in touch with us so that we can understand the basis for them. We have so far not been contacted in connection with any of the notifications. We will therefore proceed with our REACH registration strategy accordingly. If you were responsible for one or more of the classifications and overlooked our April email, please respond to it within the next seven days if you wish us to take your classification[s] into consideration.
